

Proposed Allocation of Indiana System Collections

1. Effective January 1, 2012, the revenue collected by the Indiana UCR Registration System for registrations claiming a base state other than Indiana shall be distributed as follows:
 - A. For registrations (for any active registration year) claiming a base state that has a registration percentage of at least 75% for any one of the prior 3 registration years (2009, 2010, 2011) or the current registration year, as reported by Iteris, all such revenue shall be distributed to the base state on a monthly basis.
 - B. For registrations (for any active registration year) claiming a base state that has a registration percentage of less than 75% for all of the prior 3 registration years (2009, 2010, 2011) and the current registration year, as reported by Iteris, all such revenue shall be distributed to the UCR Depository on a monthly basis.
 - C. If a base state that has not achieved a registration percentage of at least 75% for the 3 prior registration years or the current registration year as of January 1, 2012, subsequently achieves a registration percentage of at least 75% for any one of the 3 prior registration years or the current registration year, then all subsequent revenues for registrations for said base state shall be distributed to said base state.
2. Effective January 1, 2013, the revenue collected by the Indiana UCR Registration System for registrations claiming a base state other than Indiana shall be distributed as follows:
 - A. For registrations (for any active registration year) claiming a base state that has a registration percentage of at least 80% for any one of the prior 3 registration years (2010, 2011, 2012) or the current registration year, as reported by Iteris, all such revenue shall be distributed to the base state on a monthly basis.
 - B. For registrations (for any active registration year) claiming a base state that has a registration percentage of less than 80% for all of the prior 3 registration years (2010, 2011, 2012) and the current registration year, as reported by Iteris, all such revenue shall be distributed to the UCR Depository on a monthly basis.

- C. If a base state that has not achieved a registration percentage of at least 80% for the 3 prior registration years or the current registration year as of January 1, 2013, subsequently achieves a registration percentage of at least 80% for any one of the 3 prior registration years or the current registration year, then all subsequent revenues for registrations for said base state shall be distributed to said base state.

3. Effective January 1, 2014, the revenue collected by the Indiana UCR Registration System for registrations claiming a base state other than Indiana shall be distributed as follows:
 - A. For registrations (for any active registration year) claiming a base state that has a registration percentage of at least 85% for any one of the prior 3 registration years (2011, 2012, 2013) or the current registration year, as reported by Iteris, all such revenue shall be distributed to the base state on a monthly basis.
 - B. For registrations (for any active registration year) claiming a base state that has a registration percentage of less than 85% for all of the prior 3 registration years (2011, 2012, 2013) and the current registration year, as reported by Iteris, all such revenue shall be distributed to the UCR Depository on a monthly basis.
 - C. If a base state that has not achieved a registration percentage of at least 85% for the 3 prior registration years or the current registration year as of January 1, 2014, subsequently achieves a registration percentage of at least 75% for any one of the 3 prior registration years or the current registration year, then all subsequent revenues for registrations for said base state shall be distributed to said base state.

4. Effective January 1, 2015, the revenue collected by the Indiana UCR Registration System for registrations claiming a base state other than Indiana shall be distributed as follows:
 - A. For registrations (for any active registration year) claiming a base state that has a registration percentage of at least 90% for any one of the prior 3 registration years (2012, 2013, 2014) or the current registration year, as reported by Iteris, all such revenue shall be distributed to the base state on a monthly basis.
 - B. For registrations (for any active registration year) claiming a base state that has a registration percentage of less than 90% for all of the prior 3 registration years (2012, 2013, 2014) and the current registration year, as reported by

Iteris, all such revenue shall be distributed to the UCR Depository on a monthly basis.

- C. If a base state that has not achieved a registration percentage of at least 90% for the 3 prior registration years or the current registration year as of January 1, 2015, subsequently achieves a registration percentage of at least 75% for any one of the 3 prior registration years or the current registration year, then all subsequent revenues for registrations for said base state shall be distributed to said base state.
