Dear Mr. Gutierrez:

Last month I informed you of Wisconsin's continued intent to fully participate in the Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) Agreement for 2007 and beyond. I am pleased to notify the UCR Board that the State of Wisconsin has now received the required state statutory authority to participate in UCR. Governor Doyle signed the state's biennial budget into law today, October 26, 2007.

I understand that the State of Indiana has held UCR revenues collected during September 2007 from carriers who designated Wisconsin as their base state for UCR purposes. With the enactment of the budget bill, I am requesting a release of those funds to Wisconsin. Please send the monthly revenues to Ms. Candace Dyhr, as noted on forms previously filed by Wisconsin. We assume the participating states will be informed when ACH direct deposit of revenues commences.

At the request of the UCR Board, the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) headquarters recently notified its membership about which states are participating in UCRA for 2007. Now that Wisconsin is a participant, I am further requesting that the UCR Board inform CVSA and its members of the change.

I appreciate the patience of the UCR Board and other states while we waited for authorizing legislation to be enacted.
