The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) has modified its computer systems to ensure the implementation of the Unified Carrier Registration Agreement (UCRA).

The purpose of this letter is to provide additional technical information (see enclosure) on the process for a State to upload UCR payment information to FMCSA's data systems so that this information can be used to ensure compliance with UCR fee payment requirements of the UCRA. This document also provides a list of data elements available from FMCSA's data systems that States can download to use for billing purposes of UCR fees.

The UCR fee payment information will be available for viewing once received through the Motor Carrier Management Information System, Query Central, and Safety and Fitness Electronic Records System. The UCR fee payment information will be available through a new version of Inspection Selection System to be released on September 14, 2007.

Transmission of Unified Carrier Registration data between Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration and participating States Questions and Answers

- Q. If a participating State wants to send/receive United Carrier Registration(UCR) fee payment information to FMCSA, what must the State do to start the process?
- A. Any State interested in transmitting/receiving UCR data from FMCSA must start the process by applying for an account to FMCSA's Third Party Developers Partnership (3pDP). Please use the link below to apply for an account:

https://3pdp.fmcsa.dot.gov/

Once a State receives their account on 3pDP they will be able to download the transaction schema for the upload to FMCSA and the download of the UCR load file. When the State is ready to test their system with FMCSA, they will need to contact Technical Support at (617) 494-3003. Once the State system is certified, the state may begin sending the UCR payment information to FMCSA and FMCSA will begin sending the UCR load file to the State.

O. What is the UCR load file?

- A. The UCR load file is the file FMCSA will send each night to a participating UCR State. The file contains information on new carriers, as well as updates on carriers who have changed their MCS-150 information or carriers who are no longer in business.
- Q What does a participating UCR State need to send to FMCSA?
- A. A participating UCR State will send the upload transaction file to FMCSA in XML format daily. This file must contain the data elements listed on Page 2 of this document.
- Q. What will FMCSA send to a participating UCR State?
- A. On a daily basis, FMCSA will send the UCR load file to a participating State in XML format which contains the data elements listed on Page 2 of this document.
- Q. How will a roadside officer be able to view the information?
- A. A roadside officer will be able to view the UCR information in Motor Carrier Management Information Systems (MCMIS), Query Central, or Safety and Fitness Electronic Records System. Also, FMCSA will release a new version of Inspection Selection System on September 14, 2007 which will allow a roadside officer to view UCR fee payment information.
