RE: Substitution of Designated Agency to Administer UCR in Texas

Dear Mr. Quade:

The State of Texas, pursuant to 49 USCA § 14504a(e)(2)<sup>1</sup>, hereby changes the agency designated to administer and enforce the Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) agreement from the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV). Enclosed is the State of Texas' amended UCR plan, through which the State of Texas has identified TxDMV as the state agency responsible for administering the UCR agreement in Texas.

The amended state plan confirms that TxDMV has or will have the legal authority, resources and qualified personnel necessary to administer the UCR agreement in accordance with the rules and regulation promulgated by the UCRA Board of Directors, and that an amount at least equal to the revenue derived by the state from the UCR agreement will be used for motor carrier safety programs, enforcement or the administration of the UCR plan and UCR agreement.

Please substitute TxDMV for TxDOT as the responsible UCR agency for Texas. Thank you for your assistance in this matter. If I may be of further assistance, please do not hesitate to contact my office or Victor Vandergriff, Chairman of the TxDMV Board.





UNIFIED CARRIER REGISTRATION AGREEMENT  
STATE PLAN

I, Victor T. Vandergriff of the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles, on behalf of the State of Texas, as required pursuant to Section 14504a.(e) do hereby certify as follows:

1. The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles has or will have the legal authority, resources, and qualified personnel necessary to administer the agreement in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Board of Directors of the Unified Carrier Registration Act; and
2. The State shall demonstrate that an amount at least equal to the revenue derived by the State from the Unified Carrier Registration Agreement shall be used for motor carrier safety programs, enforcement, or administration of the UCR plan and UCR agreement.
