"The issue I raised [at the last UCR Board Meeting] involved the full implementation of CSA 2010 and the replacement of SAFESTAT with a new program. I was just wondering if access to the SAFER search engine is also going to be replaced. Safestat, as you know, is a sub-search under SAFER, as is access to the UCR search, so I do not believe that SAFER in general will be replaced. But I wanted to make sure of this. If there is going to be significant changes to SAFER that would alter access to the UCR search engine within SAFER, then we need to know."
