

## **ITERIS Proposal**

### **Discussion Points**

#### **Replicate Current Indiana Functionality**

This proposal implicitly and explicitly says that Iteris will provide all of the functionality currently provided by the Indiana registration site. The only exception is the Depository reporting functionality that was developed by Indiana but never vetted by the Depository Committee.

#### **Enhanced Pre-Registration Vehicle Comparisons Using IRP Data**

33 States provide their IRP registration data to the Feds. When available, Iteris will make that data a part of the registration process and notify states when “potential discrepancies” exist.

#### **Only one Web site (Except For State Systems)**

Iteris’ proposal is contingent on their registration site being the only national registration site. States may continue to operate their own registration systems provided they meet Board requirements.

#### **Provide Credit Card Payment Option For States Working In System**

Iteris will make credit card payments an option for states registering carriers in their proposed system. These payments will be processed through Iteris’ own payment engine. Credit card charges and convenience fees will be imposed on carriers who opt to pay using this option.

#### **Carrier Solicitation / Notification**

Iteris intends to solicit all “UCR Universe” carriers using the following notification options:

Email

Short Message Service (SMS)

Automated Calling

Fax Notification

When none of these options are available for a carrier, Iteris will send one or more physical mailings to the carrier. Iteris plans to include industry-relevant advertising in their physical mailings to help defray the cost of postage, envelopes, stamps, etc.

#### **Free Access To UCR-Link Tools**

Iteris intends to make the UCR-Link software a part of the registration site for states. This means that all states will have access – without cost – to a number of reporting tools, including (but not limited to):

Unregistered Carrier Reports

IRP Discrepancy Reports

Retreat Reports

New Carrier Reports

### **FMCSA Uploads/Downloads**

In addition to UCR-Link access, Iteris will upload/download all UCR and MCMIS information to and from FMCSA as a part of the proposal.

### **Willing To Help With Current Registration Efforts Upon Execution Of Contract**

Iteris will begin assisting the Board – including free access for all states to UCR-Link tools - upon execution of a contract.

### **RY2013 Would Use Iteris Registration System**

Iteris proposes having the site ready for the 2013 registration year, which will begin approximately 10/1/2012.

### **Incentives As Board Reaches Financial Milestones**

Iteris is asking for incentives contingent on the Board and the states reaching their revenue caps.

### **States Only Register Their Own Carriers**

Iteris is requesting that states only handle their own carriers. Non-participating state carriers would be directed to the Iteris Web site, where they would pay convenience fees and credit card charges. Non-participating state carriers would still, of course, have to pick a registration base state.
