AL \$100 first offense, \$500 subseq. no OOS
AR \$100-500 first offense, \$100-1000 subseq.
CA no answer ready
CO \$110 first offense, \$220 second offense, \$3300 subseq no OOS
CT \$170 fine
GA none now
ID Misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding six (6) months, or by a fine not exceeding \$1,000, or both. A citation would require a bond to be posted, the amount to be determined by a magistrate judge, but probably around \$300.
IL \$300 first offense, \$500 second
IN \$100 first offense, \$1000 subseq
IA no answer ready
KS \$100-1000 first offense, \$100-5000 subseq
KY range of \$25 to \$250
LA none now, rulemaking begun
ME \$250 OOS available to enforcement
MA \$100 first offense, \$200 subsequent offense
MI to \$500 for for hire carriers
MN \$100 fine, plus \$78 in court costs
MS no answer ready
MO varies with the county; with an audit, state can impose a general fine up to \$2000 per day
MT only a warning at this point
NE not on call
NH none now
NM \$50 penalty assessment misdemeanor, with formal proceeding, up to \$10000 per day
NY with formal proceeding, up to \$5000
NC none now
ND none now can hold IRP and IFTA renewals for UCR nonpayment

OK \$300 first offense, \$400 second, \$500 subseq

SD \$154 fine
