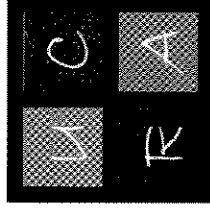

WHO FILES UNDER UCRA?

- For-hire motor carriers transporting property in interstate commerce in commercial motor vehicles that have a gross vehicle weight rating or gross vehicle weight of at least 10,001 pounds whichever is greater;
 - For-hire motor carriers transporting passengers in interstate commerce in commercial motor vehicles designed or used to transport more than 8 passengers (including the driver);
 - For-hire motor carriers transporting hazardous materials in interstate commerce and transported in a quantity requiring placarding;
 - Motor private carrier transporting property in commercial motor vehicles that have a gross vehicle weight rating or gross vehicle weight of at least 10,001 pounds whichever is greater;
 - Brokers;
 - Freight Forwarders; or
 - Leasing Companies.
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WHAT AMI REQUIRED TO DO?

- File an annual application; and
 - Pay an annual fee.
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WHERE DO I GET FORMS & INSTRUCTIONS?

There is a national web base system where you can get forms, contact us information and instructions on how you select your base state for filing. You may also file directly on line at this site. The web site address is: www.ucr.in.gov

AMI REQUIRED TO CARRY A CREDENTIAL IN THE VEHICLE?

No. You may want, but are not required, to carry in the vehicle a copy of the receipt issued when fees have been paid.

WHAT ARE THE FEES?

The fees can vary each year. The fee is a flat per carrier fee and is determined by the number of commercial motor vehicle (including trailers) you reported on your last MCS-150 form sent to Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. Brokers, freight forwarders and leasing companies pay the lowest fee.

CAN I PAY THE FEES ON-LINE?

You can pay your fees using MasterCard, Visa or an electronic e-check when you use the national web base system. If you file in your base state, check with that state on what types of payment options they have available for you.
