Dear Chairman Gutierrez:

I understand that the Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) Board is scheduled to meet on Wednesday June 9, 2010, and I wish to thank you for your leadership on important matters before the Board. I wish to bring to your attention a recent effort to clarify the intent of language included in the Rail Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (RSIA; P.L. 110-432), exempting certain carriers in Hawaii's motor carrier fleet from the provisions of the Unified Carrier Registration Agreement (UCRA).

In 2008, I included this language in the RSIA to address a problem which is specific and unique to Hawaii. Under the UCRA program, participating states that neighbor non-participating states are able to collect monies from motor carriers in non-participating states, as there is a logical assumption that the motor carriers could travel there. However, Hawaii does not participate in the UCRA program. Hawaii's motor carriers do not travel to other states. The language that I had included in the RSIA was intended to make clear that Hawaii motor carriers (private and for-hire) that operate solely within the state are not subject to the UCRA program. It also makes clear that the UCR Board has the discretion and authority to further exempt certain motor carriers from the program.

It has come to my attention that despite this legislative language, several states have continued to send notice to Hawaii motor carriers of the requirement to register and pay the UCRA fee. I understand that you recently filed a motion for the UCR Board to exempt certain motor carriers in an effort to make clear to these other states which of its motor carriers are exempt. I believe that this petition is consistent with statutory language, and it upholds our intent under the RSIA. Therefore, within existing rules and regulations, I wish to request that the Board re-consider the motion that was offered at your previous meeting, which would exclude Hawaii motor carriers from the UCRA program.
